1 HOME ▶ BARI

Meals on Board Assemble at the airport and take-off to Bari, capital of southern Italy's Puglia region.

02 BARI ALBEROBELLO MATERA

Light Lunch with wine, Hotel Dinner Explore the UNESCO-listed fairy-tale town of Alberobello, famed for its 14th-century Trulli—stone houses built without mortar. Start at Trullo Sovrano, the only two-story trullo turned museum, then head to Rione Aia Piccola for the most Instagramworthy views of the medieval village. Then, immerse yourself in local culture with a visit a familyrun Dairy Farm to make fresh mozzarella and sample a selection of specialty cheeses, paired with a light lunch and local wine.

03 MATERA > NAPLES -

Breakfast

Explore another UNESCO World Heritage Site in Matera with a guided tour of the remarkable Sassi. Discover the ancient troglodyte dwellings and rock-hewn churches, where the cave-dwelling district is perfectly adapted to the terrain and ecosystem. Visit Casa Grotta and other captivating sites for a glimpse into the region's ancient history. Transfer to Naples, you will board an overnight ferry from Naples to Palermo.

Note: The overnight ferry offers outside cabin with bunk beds includes a shower and toilet. Pack a small, accessible bag for convenience.

04 PALERMO MONREALE CEFALU PALERMO

Breakfast (on board), Hotel Dinner Arrive in Palermo and set out on a guided walking tour through its historic heart. Discover iconic sights like Quattro Canti, Piazza

Cathedral. Marvel at the dazzling mosaics of the Palatine Chapel, a UNESCO World Heritage site. Next head to Monreale to visit its majestic Norman cathedral. End the day in the charming seaside town of Cefalù, where you'll see the medieval stone fountain and take in the coastal views from Porta Marina.

05 PALERMO ▶ AGRIGENTO

Breakfast, Dinner

Start with a photo stop at the stunning Scala dei Turchi, white limestone cliffs cascading into the Mediterranean. Then, in Agrigento, explore the Valley of the Temples, a UNESCO site home to the majestic Temple of Concord and the scenic Temple of Juno, overlooking the sea.

06 AGRIGENTO ▶ CATANIA Breakfast, Dinner – Lobster Pasta

+ Wine

Enjoy shopping at Sicilia Outlet Village, with designer brands up to 70% off. Then head to Catania for an orientation tour starting at Piazza del Duomo, featuring the Fontana dell'Elefante and Cathedral of Sant'Agata. Visit the lively La Pescheria Market, stroll along Via Etnea, Via Crociferi and San Benedetto Church, and end at Piazza Stesicoro with its Roman Amphitheater ruins.

Breakfast, Seafood Dinner + Wine Embark on a thrilling Jeep tour of Mount Etna, Europe's highest active volcano. Ride a cable car to 2500m, then continue by 4x4 to Torre del Filosofo at 2900m. With a volcano guide, explore the crater's edge and take in stunning summit views. Continue to Taormina to visit the ancient Greek Theatre, framed by Mount Etna, and end the day with a leisurely stroll through the town's charming old streets.

08 CATANIA — VALLETTA Breakfast

Enjoy a free day or join an optional tour to Syracuse's archaeological park, featuring 'the Greek Theatre and Roman Amphitheatre. Then stroll through Ortigia Island's baroque streets, see the Cathedral, and explore the lively market. In the evening, take a scenic 1hr45min speedboat ride to Malta, a small island rich in heritage. Optional: Syracuse & Ortigia Island Tour









09 VALLETTA > MDINA > MARSAXLOOK > **VALLETTA**

Breakfast, Seafood Lunch, Hotel Dinner Discover Malta's rich history, begin with a photo stop at San Anton Gardens, then visit the Mdina Cathedral Museum in the ancient "Silent City." Capture views of Palazzo Falson and Greek's Gate before heading to Marsaxlokk, a colorful fishing village with a lively market. End the day exploring the iconic Three Cities—Vittoriosa, Senglea, and Cospicua with their historic walls and charming streets.

10 VALLETTA (FREE DAY) Breakfast

Enjoy a free day or take an optional trip to Gozo, with a scenic ferry ride and a photo stop at Popeye Village, the colorful 1980 film set. Optional: Gozo Island & Popeye Village Tour

Breakfast, Meals on Board Begin with a photo stop at the stunning Blue Grotto, if weather permitting, opt for a boat ride through its famous sea caves. Visit the impressive St. John's Co-Cathedral, home to two Caravaggio masterpieces and rich Baroque interiors. Stop at charming Old Mint Street, then unwind at the Upper Barrakka Gardens with panoramic views of the Grand Harbour. Enjoy free time before transfer to the airport for the flight home.
