HOME ▶ JEDDAH

Meals on Board Assemble at the airport for your flight to Jeddah, the city is known as the "Bride of the Red Sea" and is one of the most beautiful cities in Saudi Arabia.

2 JEDDAH Lunch, Dinner

Upon arrival, begin your journey in Jeddah with a visit to Jeddah Park, a modern complex perfect for shopping, dining, and leisure activities. Then, immerse yourself in history at the Museum of Islamic Arts, which showcases an exquisite collection of Islamic artifacts. Continue to Teamlab, an interactive digital art space, for a unique and engaging experience. After lunch, explore the historic Al Balad District, a UNESCO World Heritage Site with its traditional coral-stone buildings and vibrant souks. Conclude your tour with a relaxing stroll along the scenic Jeddah Corniche, taking in the Red Sea views and the towering King Fahd Fountain. End your day with a visit to the serene Floating Mosque, followed by a delightful dinner.



03 JEDDAH ▶ MADINAH

Breakfast, Lunch, Chinese Dinner Board the high-speed train to Madinah and explore the city's rich spiritual and historical heritage on this unforgettable tour. Begin with an exterior visit to the Prophet's Mosque (Al-Masjid an-Nabawi), the final resting place of the Prophet Muhammad, followed by a stroll along the historic Oiba Street. which connects two of Islam's most important landmarks. Here, you'll also see Quba Mosque—the first mosque ever built—while enjoying the vibrant atmosphere of local snack vendors and traditional food shops. Stop for a photo at Mount Uhud, the site of a pivotal battle in Islamic history. The journey continues at the

Dar Al Madinah Museum,

where detailed exhibits, rare manuscripts, and architectural models showcase the city's evolution over 1,400 years1. Conclude your experience at the Suwaigah Soug, a bustling traditional market renowned for its textiles, perfumes, and goldperfect for immersing yourself in Madinah's authentic culture. Note: Please note that Dar Al Madinah Museum is closed on Fridays. Train from Jeddah to Madinah (1 hr 50 mins with 25 KG luggage allowance).

04 MADINAH ▶ ALULA Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

Begin your day with breakfast before traveling to AlUla, a breathtaking desert destination renowned for its natural and historical treasures. Enjoy a guided tour of Hegra (Madain Saleh)-Saudi Arabia's first UNESCO World Heritage Site—featuring ancient Nabatean tombs carved into sandstone cliffs. As an optional experience, you may choose to explore the site in vintage Land Rovers (maximum 14 guests per vehicle), offering a nostalgic and intimate way to discover the desert landscape. Marvel at Elephant Rock, a striking natural formation sculpted by wind and time. End your day with a magical sunset in AlUla's Old Town, followed by a memorable dinner under the stars.

05 ALULA

Breakfast

Begin your AlUla adventure with an optional Hot Air Balloon Ride at sunrise—a breathtaking experience offering a serene flight over the majestic landscapes of AlUla. Drift above the UNESCO World Heritage Site of Hegra, passing dramatic rock formations and lush oases as the morning light paints the desert in unforgettable hues. Later, explore Maraya, the world's largest mirrored building, which seamlessly reflects the beauty of Ashar Valley. This architectural wonder celebrates AlUla's historical role as a cultural crossroads. Continue your journey with a walk-through AlUla Old Town, where Old Market Street invites you to discover artisan shops, local delicacies, and traditional crafts that bring the town's vibrant heritage to life. As night falls, an optional Stargazing Tour (starts at 5 PM) at Garamel awaitsan ideal desert location far from city lights. Led by local experts, this magical experience under one of the world's clearest skies concludes around 11 PM, leaving

you with lasting memories of AlUla's natural and cultural wonders.

06 ALULA ▶ RIYADH Breakfast, Dinner

After breakfast, take a domestic flight to Riyadh, the vibrant capital of Saudi Arabia. In the evening, visit Riyadh Boulevard City, a lively entertainment hub where people of all ages gather to stroll, dine, and enjoy the energetic atmosphere. With modern attractions, global cuisine, and immersive experiences, it's a must-visit for families, solo travelers, and adventure seekers alike. Enjoy dinner before heading back to your hotel to check in and rest for the night.

07 RIYADH

Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner After breakfast, begin your journey through Riyadh's rich heritage with a visit to Diriyah, home to the Al Turaif UNESCO World Heritage Site, famed for its striking Najdi architecture. Continue with a guided Riyadh City Tour, starting at the historic Al Masmak Fortress, followed by a walk through Souq Al-Zal, one of the city's oldest traditional markets. Dive into Saudi Arabia's culture at the National Museum in the King Abdulaziz Historical Center, then head to the Kingdom Centre Tower, where the Sky Bridge offers stunning views of Riyadh's skyline. End your day with a farewell dinner at Takya, where modern Saudi cuisine meets creative flavours in an elegant setting.

Enjoy a free day in Riyadh to explore at your own pace whether shopping, revisiting favorite spots, or soaking in the local culture. For a truly memorable experience, consider an optional excursion to the Edge of the World (Jebel Fihrayn). Part of the Tuwaig Escarpment, this breathtaking site features 300-meter-high cliffs rising above an ancient ocean bed, offering panoramic desert views and fossil-rich terrain. A must-visit for nature lovers and photographers alike.
