



## 6天5晚 奇遇黄山+水墨徽州+千岛湖 (上海/杭州/千岛湖/黄山/屯溪)

### 第一天 吉隆坡-上海（机上用餐）

酒店：华美达安可或青浦新城智选假日酒店或同级

从吉隆坡国际机场出发，乘机飞往上海。抵达后，由当地导游接机后入住酒店休息。

### 第二天 上海-杭州（早/午/晚餐）

酒店：西溪格雷酒店或同级

早餐后，前往南京路步行街，这里是上海最繁华的商业街之一，汇聚百年老字号、国际品牌与特色美食，洋溢着现代都市的繁华魅力。随后漫步于外滩，欣赏黄浦江两岸的迷人景致，一边是充满历史韵味的万国建筑群，另一边则是陆家嘴现代摩天大楼群，展现上海古今交融的独特风貌。接着前往城隍庙商圈，这里融合传统文化、美食与购物于一体，古色古香的建筑群中汇聚各式上海特色小吃、传统手工艺品及特色商店，是体验老上海风情的必访景点。随后，前往游览西溪国家湿地公园，这里是中国首个国家湿地公园，也是集自然生态、湿地景观与人文风情于一体的生态旅游胜地。漫步于绿意盎然的湿地栈道，欣赏纵横交错的河道、茂密的芦苇与丰富的生态景观。

### 第三天 杭州-千岛湖（早/午/晚餐）

酒店：啤酒温泉酒店或同级

早餐后，前往**体验汉服采茶与品茶**，深入了解中国茶文化与制茶工艺。随后前往游览**青山湖水上森林（含游船）**，乘船穿梭于茂密的池杉林间，欣赏树木自水中生长而出的奇特景观。四周绿意盎然，湖水宁静如镜，宛如置身童话秘境，是杭州近年最受欢迎的生态景点之一。接着，前往**千岛湖啤酒小镇**，欧式风情建筑与湖畔美景相互辉映，漫步其中，感受浓厚的异国小镇氛围。参观**啤酒博物馆**，深入了解啤酒的发展历史、酿造工艺及啤酒文化，体验千岛湖独特的啤酒魅力。



### 第四天 千岛湖-屯溪（早/午/-）

酒店：柏景假日酒店或同级

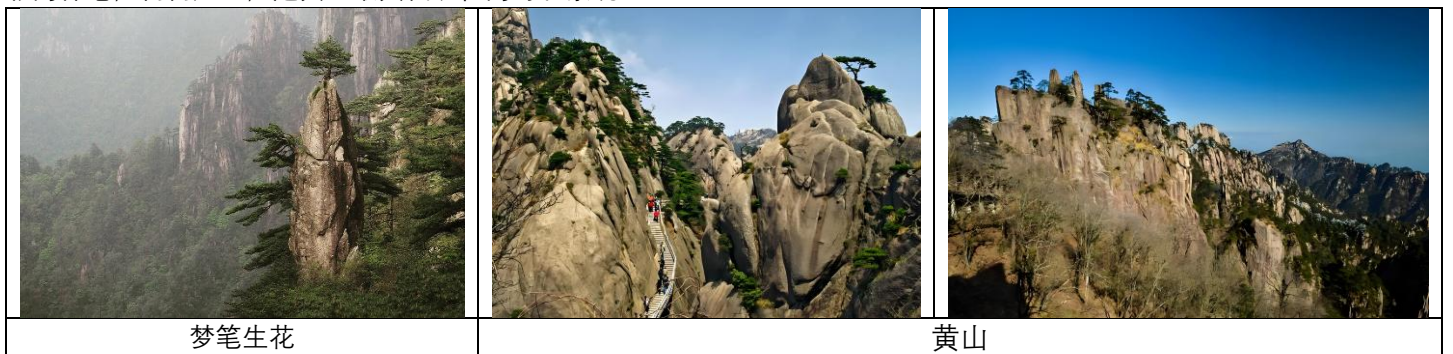
早餐后，前往**船游千岛湖**，欣赏被誉为“天下第一秀水”的湖光山色。碧波荡漾的湖面点缀着大小岛屿，山水相映，景色如诗如画。随后登上**揽月岛**，近距离感受千岛湖的自然生态与秀丽风光。特别安排观赏震撼的**巨网捕鱼**表演，体验当地传统渔业文化，欣赏渔民合力起网的壮观场面，感受人与自然的和谐共生的独特魅力。接着，游览**徽州古城**这里保留了最完整的明清古城格局，粉墙黛瓦在青石板路间延伸，古韵悠远。漫步**斗山街**，街巷两旁是传统徽派店铺，茶铺、手工艺与地方小吃交织出浓厚的市井生活气息。随后参观明代皇家御赐的**许国石坊**，八柱五楼的宏伟结构雕刻精细，被誉为“徽州牌坊艺术的经典之作”，雄伟壮观。随后前往**黎阳水街**坐落于新安江畔，是将徽州传统建筑与现代休闲文化完美结合的特色水街。这里集美食、文创、茶馆与手作体验于一体，可品尝徽州地道小吃，漫步古巷间感受江南水乡与徽州文化交织的独特魅力。



### 第五天 屯溪-黄山-屯溪（早/午/晚餐）

酒店：柏景假日酒店或同级

早餐后，前往游览世界文化与自然双遗产-**黄山风景区**，特别安排**太平缆车往返**，轻松登临“中国第一奇山”。游览**北海景区**，这里是黄山风景的精华所在，以奇松、怪石、云海闻名。随后前往**排云亭**，这里是观赏西海群峰与壮丽云海的绝佳地点，群山连绵、峰峦叠翠，景色气势磅礴。接着欣赏黄山著名景点**梦笔生花**，奇峰顶端耸立着一株苍劲古松，宛如一支蘸满墨彩的神笔，栩栩如生，是黄山最具代表性的奇石景观之一。



## 第六天 屯溪-吉隆坡（早/午/机上用餐）

早餐后，前往**徽州博物馆**，通过精心挑选的展品、展板、动画和沙盘等多种形式，深入展示徽州地区的历史变迁。常展分为多个主题，如“天下徽州”、“遥忆徽州”、“寻根徽州”等，带领观众穿越时空，感受徽州文化的深厚底蕴。午餐后，送往黄山屯溪国际机场，准备办理登机返回吉隆坡

**(SHANGHAI/HANGZHOU/THOUSAND ISLAND/HUANGSHAN/TUNXI)**

**DAY 1: KUALA LUMPUR– SHANGHAI(MOB)**

Assemble at Kuala Lumpur International Airport and proceed with check-in formalities for your flight to **Shanghai**. Upon arrival, meet your local guide and transfer to the hotel for check-in and rest.

**DAY 2: SHANGHAI-WUXI (B/L/D)**

After breakfast, visit **Nanjing Road Pedestrian Street**, Shanghai's most famous shopping boulevard, where century-old brands, international boutiques, and local delicacies come together to showcase the city's vibrant metropolitan lifestyle. Next, take a stroll along **The Bund**, one of Shanghai's most iconic landmarks. Admire the magnificent contrast between the historic European-style buildings on one side of the Huangpu River and the modern skyscrapers of Lujiazui on the other, reflecting the perfect blend of Shanghai's past and present. Continue to the lively **Chenghuang Temple**, a popular destination that combines traditional architecture, local snacks, shopping, and cultural attractions. Wander through its charming streets while experiencing the unique atmosphere of old Shanghai. Afterwards, visit **Xixi National Wetland Park**, China's first national wetland park. Renowned for its beautiful waterways, lush reed beds, and rich ecological environment, the park offers a peaceful escape into nature. Wander along the scenic boardwalks and immerse yourself in the tranquil beauty of this unique wetland landscape.

**DAY 3: HANGZHOU-THOUSAND ISLAND (B/L/D)**

After breakfast, experience a traditional **Hanfu Tea-Picking Experience**, where you can dress in elegant Hanfu attire and learn the art of tea picking while gaining a deeper understanding of China's rich tea culture and traditional tea-making process. Next, visit the enchanting **Qingshan Lake Water Forest (boat ride included)**. Cruise through tranquil waterways surrounded by towering bald cypress trees rising from the water, creating a fairytale-like landscape. The lush greenery and mirror-like reflections make this one of Hangzhou's most picturesque ecological attractions. Continue to **Qiandao Lake Beer Town**, where charming European-style architecture blends beautifully with the scenic lakeside surroundings, creating a unique and relaxing atmosphere. Afterwards, visit the **Beer Museum** to discover the history of beer, its brewing process, and beer culture while experiencing the distinctive charm of Qiandao Lake's brewing heritage.

**DAY 4: THOUSAND ISLAND-TUNXI (B/L/-)**

After breakfast, enjoy a scenic **cruise on Qiandao Lake**, renowned as the "Most Beautiful Water under Heaven." Admire the crystal-clear waters dotted with countless islands, where the harmonious blend of mountains and lakes creates a breathtaking landscape. Continue to **Lanyue Island**, where you can appreciate the lake's pristine natural beauty up close. A special highlight is the spectacular **Giant Net Fishing Demonstration**, showcasing the traditional fishing culture of Qiandao Lake as local fishermen work together to haul in a massive fishing net, offering a fascinating glimpse into the region's fishing heritage. Next, visit **Huizhou Ancient City**, one of China's best-preserved ancient cities, retaining its original Ming and Qing Dynasty layout. Wander through its ancient streets lined with whitewashed walls and black-tiled houses, then stroll along Doushan Street, where traditional Huizhou-style shops, tea houses, handicraft stores, and local snack stalls offer an authentic taste of local life. Continue to the magnificent **Xuguo Memorial Archway**, an imperial stone archway bestowed by the Ming Emperor. Featuring its unique eight-column, five-bay structure and exquisite stone carvings, it is regarded as a masterpiece of Huizhou archway architecture. Finally, proceed to **Liyang Water Street**, stroll through its charming lanes, savour authentic Huizhou snacks, and experience the unique fusion of Jiangnan water town scenery and Huizhou cultural heritage.

**DAY 5: TUNXI-HUANGSHAN-TUNXI (B/L/D)**

After breakfast, visit **Huangshan Scenic Area**, a UNESCO World Cultural and Natural Heritage Site. A round-trip Taiping Cable Car ride is included, allowing you to ascend comfortably to China's No.1 Marvelous Mountain. Explore the **Beihai Scenic Area**, the heart of Huangshan, renowned for its magnificent peculiar pine trees, unique rock formations, and breathtaking sea of clouds. Continue to **Paiyun Pavilion**, one of the best viewpoints for admiring the spectacular peaks of the West Sea Canyon, where layers of majestic mountains create an awe-inspiring panorama. Finally, visit the famous **Mengbi Shenghua**, one of Huangshan's most iconic attractions. A centuries-old pine tree stands gracefully atop a towering rock, resembling a giant writing brush blooming with flowers. This remarkable natural formation is regarded as one of the finest examples of Huangshan's extraordinary rock formations and showcases the mountain's unique natural beauty.

#### **DAY 6: TUNXI-KUALA LUMPUR (B/L/MOB)**

After breakfast, visit to **Huizhou Museum** display the historical changes of the Huizhou thru exhibits, display boards, animations, sand tables and other. The exhibited hall divided into several themes, such as "Huizhou in the World", "Remembering Huizhou", "Finding Ancestor Trip in Huizhou" etc. which leading the audience to travel through time and space and feel the profound heritage of Huizhou culture. After lunch, transfer to **Tunxi International Airport** and proceed with check-in formalities for your flight back to Kuala Lumpur
