Day 1

SINGAPORE ✈️ PARO - THIMPHU
Meals on Board, Lunch, Dinner

- Scenic Himalayan Flight: Enjoy breathtaking views of snow-capped peaks, valleys, and terraced fields.
- Chuzom: Visit the confluence of Paro & Thimphu Rivers, marked by three distinctive stupas.
- Tachog Lhakhang: Explore the “Temple of the Iron Bridge,” linked to the 15th-century saint Thangtong Gyalpo.
- Paro - Thimphu (55 km / ~1.5 hrs)
- Lunch (Thimphu): Bhutanese meal at a local restaurant.
- King’s Memorial Chorten & Craft Bazaar: Photo stop + handicrafts/souvenirs shopping.
- Overnight at Thimphu

Day 2

THIMPHU CITY DISCOVERY
Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

- Simtokha Dzong (1627): Bhutan’s oldest fortress—serene, spiritual atmosphere.
- Buddha Point (Kuensel Phodrang): Giant Buddha Dordenma + panoramic Thimphu Valley views.
- Folk Heritage Museum: Traditional Bhutanese farmhouse experience—local lifestyle & craftsmanship.
- Takin Reserve: See Bhutan’s national animal (unique “goat-cow” look).
- Weekend Market: Lively local market—produce, textiles, crafts & souvenirs.
- Tashichho Dzong: Royal & monastic fortress—home to the King’s throne room (exterior/visit subject to access).

Day 3

THIMPHU → PUNAKHA (75 KM / ~3 HRS)
Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

- Dochula Pass (3,080m): 360° Himalayan views on clear days + photo stop at 108 Druk Wangyal Chortens.
- Picnic Lunch by Mo Chhu River: Serene riverside setting with valley views.
- Mo Chhu River Rafting (Optional/Subject to conditions): Gentle rafting—beginner-friendly and scenic.
- Punakha Dzong: “Palace of Great Happiness” — masterpiece of Bhutanese architecture & murals.
- Punakha Suspension Bridge (180m): Stunning river valley views and photo moments.

Day 4

PUNAKHA → PARO (120 KM / ~4.5 HRS)
bBreakfast, Lunch, Dinner

- Chimi Lhakhang Hike (Temple of Fertility): Easy walk through fields & villages to this famous temple linked to the “Divine Madman.”
- Scenic Drive back to Paro: Cross Dochula again with fresh viewpoints of valleys and villages.
- Ta Dzong (National Museum): Art, ancient weapons, costumes & religious artifacts (former watchtower).
- Rinpung Dzong (Paro Dzong): “Fortress of the Heap of Jewels” — impressive murals & monastic heritage.

Day 5

TIGER’S NEST (TAKTSANG) + LOCAL EXPERIENCE
Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

- Tiger’s Nest Hike: Bhutan’s most iconic monastery, dramatically perched ~900m above Paro Valley. Learn the legend of Guru Rinpoche and soak in the spiritual atmosphere.
- Local Farmhouse Visit: Try Bhutan’s national sport archery, interact with villagers, and learn about traditional crafts/cooking & daily life.
- Optional Hot Stone Bath: Traditional herbal wellness soak—perfect after the hike.
- Farewell Dinner & Cultural Show: Authentic Bhutanese dishes with local music & dance performances.

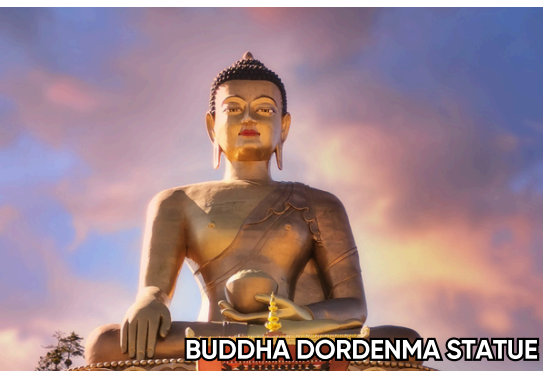
