18°C Chocolate Factory: 18°C Chocolate Factory is a well-known tourist factory in Nantou. It is famous for its handmade chocolate, gelato, raw toast, etc. It emphasizes that "18°C" is the best storage and tasting temperature for chocolate, symbolizing its insistence on quality. In addition to providing a variety of desserts and souvenirs, the workshop also provides services such as cafes and interactive experiences, making it one of the important tourist attractions.

Sun Moon Lake Scenic Area: The largest freshwater lake in Taiwan, surrounded by mountains and green mountains, the scenery of the mountains and rivers is very beautiful. The south is shaped like the arc of the moon, and the north is shaped like the sun, so it is called "Sun Moon Lake". It is a must-visit attraction for tourists from all over the world to Taiwan.

Yida Shao Old Street: Located in front of Yida Shao Pier in Yuchi Sun Moon Lake, with a total length of about 300 meters, it is an old shop street with rich local characteristics.

Miyahara Eye Clinic: Originally an eye clinic in the Japanese period, it was later renovated and renovated into a new era building. It has become an internet celebrity check-in attraction and is also a well-known ice cream shop in Taichung.

Yizhong Night Market: Yizhong Night Market is a well-known night market in Taichung, famous for its delicious snacks and cheap clothes and shoes. Shifen Old Street: Shifen Old Street is located on both sides of the tracks at Shifen Station, the largest train station in the Pingxi area. There are quite a few sky lantern souvenir shops on both sides of the street.

It can be said to be the faith center and administrative center of the Taiwanese Muslim community. In addition, with its rich Islamic elements, Taipei Mosque has become an important channel for people in Taipei and schools at all levels to understand Islamic culture through visits or off-campus teaching.
