


# 04 SWEDISH LAPLAND - ROVANIEMI - FINNISH LAPLAND


# 08 VARDØ - HAVILA CRUISE

# 10 HAVILA CRUISE TROMSØ - STOKMARKNES - SVOLVAER - STAMSUND

The famous 1890 fishing boat battle took place here, which has become an important chapter in Norwegian history and culture. Trollfjord connects Svolvær and Stokmarknes and is a must-see place for polar voyages.
- Disembark at **Svolvær**, is the capital city and the gateway to Lofoten. Free at leisure in this town which surrounded by a
- beautiful landscape, tucked between tall mountains and
- the fjord and sea right in front of the city center.
- Continue cruising to **Stamsund**.
