

Day 1 SINGAPORE > CAIRO

Meal on Board

Assemble at Singapore Changi Airport for your flight to Cairo, Egypt.

Day 2 CAIRO

Lunch / Dinner

Upon arrival in **Cairo**, meet and greet by a local representative.

Egyptian Museum: With over 120,000 artefacts, the museum houses an unbelievable exhibit depicting ancient Egypt's glorious reign. One of the most famous exhibits is Mask of Tutankhamun. (Entry to Mummies Room is not included, a separate fee applies)

Coptic Cairo: Christian heritage area of Cairo. Visit the Hanging Church, Monastery of St George, Church of St. Sergius and St Bacchus, Ben Ezra Synagogue and Church of St Barbara.

Islamic Cairo: Visit Salahdin Citadel, a medieval Islamic fortification in Cairo and the Mosque of Mohammed Ali.





Day 3 CAIRO

Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner

Giza: Visit **Great Pyramid of Giza** and the **Great Sphinx**. Enjoy Camel Riding.

Saqqara: Visit the Step Pyramid of King Djoser, constructed at Saqqara about 4,700 years ago; it was the first pyramid the Egyptians built.

Memphis: The capital of Egypt during the Old Kingdom is now an open-air museum. See the massive Statue of Ramesses II that was uncovered here, measuring over 30 feet tall.





Day 4 CAIRO > ASWAN (NILE CRUISE)

Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner

Catch a domestic flight to Aswan (approx. 1.5hr) **Aswan:** Visit the Aswan High Dam, Lake Nasser and Unfinished Obelisk.

Agilkia Island: Take a **Boat Ride** to visit the Temple of Philae, dedicated to the goddess Isis. A massive UNESCO project to move the temple to higher ground on nearby Agilkia Island when Aswan Dam was constructed to prevent the temple from inundated by the rising waters of Lake Nasser. Enjoy a relaxing **Felucca Ride** to view the Agha Khan Mausoleum and Kitchener Island.

Optional Excursion: Visit the colourful Nubian Village

Day 5 ASWAN - ABU SIMBEL - ASWAN > KOM OMBO > EDFU

Box Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner

Depart early in the morning to visit **Abu Simbel Temples** by coach, a UNESCO World Heritage Site.

Domestic flight to visit Abu Simbel Temples is available for selected departure dates

Abu Simbel: Two magnificent temples that were originally carved out of solid rock on a mountainside way back in the 13th century BC, to honour the great pharaoh Ramses II and his wife Nefertari. Return to Aswan and sail to Kom Ombo.

Kom Ombo: Visit the Double Temple of Sobek and Haroeris, the crocodile god the falcon god. Visit Crocodile Museum and see. Continue to sail to Edfu. After Dinner, dressed up and enjoy Galabeya's Party, a night of dancing and music.





Day 6 EDFU > ESNA LOCK > LUXOR

Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner

Edfu: Take a **Horse Carriage ride** to visit the Temple of Edfu. Built between 237 and 57 BC, the temple is dedicated to the falcon-god Horus, is also one of the best preserved ancient monuments in Egypt. Sail and cross the Esna Lock, and continue to sail to Luxor.





Day 7 LUXOR - HURGHADA (RED SEA)

Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner

Luxor: Visit **Valley of the Kings**, part of the ancient city of Thebes and was the burial site of almost all the pharaohs of the 18th, 19th, and 20th dynasties (1539 – 1075 BCE).

The Mortuary Temple of Queen Hatshepsut, named after the only female Pharaoh in ancient Egyptian history, Queen Hatshepsut had her own Temple within the area known as the Valley of the Queens on the West Bank of Luxor.

Colossi of Memnon, the twin colossi depict the Pharaoh Amenhotep III, who ruled during the 18th Dynasty. They once flanked the entrance to his lost mortuary temple, which at its height was the most lavish temple in all of Egypt.

Luxor Temple, constructed over hundreds of years by Amenhotep III, Ramesses II, Tutankhamun, and other pharaohs, this temple was the largest and most significant religious center in ancient Egypt.

Karnak Temple, developed over more than 1,000 years, at its peak, the largest and most important religious complex in ancient Egypt.

Transfer to Hurghada, Red Sea.

Optional Excursion: Sunrise Hot Air Balloon. Enjoy a mesmerizing sunrise in the sky, overlooking the majestic ancient ruins.









Day 8 HURGHADA

Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner

Hurghada: Enjoy a **Glass Bottom Boat** tour in the Red Sea, to see colourful corals and fishes. Free at leisure in the afternoon.

Optional Excursion: Bedouin Village and Quad Bike Desert Safari.





Day 9 HURGHADA > CAIRO

Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner

Catch a domestic flight to Cairo (approx. 1hr)

Cairo: Visit the Papyrus Institute where you can see a demonstration of how this ancient type of paper is made. **Khan el-Khalili Bazaar**: a traditional arab souk with bountiful cafes, restaurants, plenty of clothing, spices, traditional jewelry and perfumes shops.





Day 10 CAIRO > SINGAPORE

Breakfast / Meals on Board

Free at leisure in the morning till your transfer to Cairo International Airport for your flight home.
